Dementia – - West Kent diagnosis rates against estimated prevalence has increased to 59.9% - Plans to improve diagnosis rates and care in nursing homes Primary Care Mental Health Specialist Service - Launch of Depot LES - Agreement to expand service with 2 additional Primary Care Mental Health Specialist nurses Eating Disorder Service redesign - Joint referral pathway for CAMHS and adult services agreed by clinical workgroup - Financial allocation agreed - KMPT and SPFT working in partnership to develop all age pathway CAMHS – Dave Holman - Contract procurement plan to be developed with support from CSU - Collaborative Commissioning and Procurement Board has met twice - Key decision to extend SPFT health contract to April 2017, new timeline agreed - Early help contract procurement award still planned for October 2016 Improving Access to Psychological Therapies (IAPT) – - New national Access and Waiting Times standards 2015/16 implemented. - Name change Addaction (previously KCA(UK)) - Bexley Mind – No new referrals with immediate effect. Service will continue to treat all existing patients but any new patients need to be directed to one of the other providers. - Publicity material available. Crisis Care/Urgent care – Dave Holman - Crisis Care Concordat Plan reviewed and new Plan and KPI's uploaded to website - Street Triage model commenced Dec 2015 - Psychiatric Liaison cover increased at MTW hospitals including service for young people Learning Disabilities – Chris Hird - Pilot scheme for CLDT GP based clinics to increase no. of annual health checks finalized with CLDT Matrons from SW Kent and Maidstone & Malling areas - Email all Practice Managers to encourage delivery of LD Annual Health Checks - Continue work with CCG Quality/Safeguarding Team in plans to introduce a LD liaison nurse at MTW. Risk assessment now carried out, joint post with KCHFT being proposed by MTW Mental Health Placements – Chris Hird - Continue to monitor high cost placements through attendance at CPA meetings Neurodevelopmental Pathway – Chris Hird - Psicon commenced ASD assessments transferred from KMPT waiting list, a further 30 cases have been transferred for assessment in January.
